COMPETITION RULES:

1. No refunds after entries received.
2. First to enter, last to dance.
3. Dancers will pick up numbers at registration table upon verification of SOBHD card.
4. Age categories will be based on number of registrants in each classification.
5. No coaching allowed by teachers or parents while dancers are on stage.
6. Dancers must be ready to dance at assigned times.
7. Dancers must fill in for the reel or risk being disqualified.
8. Medals will be awarded from Primary to Premier categories. Adult Premier category will receive cash awards to third place. All high aggregate winners with the exception of the Primary category will receive trophies.
9. Competitors must present a valid SOBHD card to receive awards.
10. Dancers must be in full dress to receive awards.
11. Scrutineering shall be conducted as recommended by SOBHD. Judges decisions will be final and there will be no access to the judges sheets.
12. Any protest must be lodged in writing and postmarked within 7 days, accompanied by a \$25.00 fee, which will be returned if the protest is upheld.
13. HHDA will not be responsible for lost articles, accidents, injuries or illness to competitors or spectators at the competition.
