1. No refunds for competition entries will be granted.
2. Numbers to be picked up at the registration desk located in the foyer of the Civic Centre.
3. Late entries may not appear in the program.
4. First to enter; last to dance.
5. SOBHD cards must be presented or awards will be withheld.
6. The Port Hawkesbury Highland Dancing Association will follow the rules and regulations set forth by SOBHD.
7. Dancers will be judged according to the technique of SOBHD. Judges decision is final. No access to judge's sheets.
8. Scrutineering shall be conducted as recommended by SOBHD.
9. Dancers must report promptly when called or risk disqualification.
10. Protests may be lodged to the Port Hawkesbury Highland Dance Association according to the rules of SOBHD.
11. Port Hawkesbury Highland Dance Association is not responsible for accidents, injuries, or lost articles.
12. Dancers must be in full dress (including slippers) to receive awards.
13. Trophies will be awarded in all categories except Primary.
