



HHDA Funding/Sponsorship Policy

Over the past several years, HHDA has been in the financial position to provide funding to provincial reps participating in the ScotDance Canada Championship Series and dancers participating in international tattoos.

In keeping with our guidelines for the HHDA scholarship and the 2008 Teacher Sponsorship program, anyone applying for funding must be a current member of HHDA and have been a member for the past 2 full calendar years. Applicants must also meet at least three of following commitments to HHDA to be considered for funding.

- Attend at least one HHDA sponsored workshop;
- Perform in the annual St. Andrew's Day Tea Performance
- Volunteer at HHDA competitions, championship and games (parents or dancers)
- Volunteer to dance at performances to help promote HHDA/Highland Dance

This policy will be effective immediately. Dancer is required to submit a request to the association detailing their commitment to HHDA for consideration of funding.
